Health & Safety Statement

Non-compliance with these requirements will be taken seriously and regarded as a breach of employment contract and the company reserves the right to take further action.

To assist in the implementation of this policy, employees will be consulted regularly on issues embracing health and safety.

Health and safety arrangements will be reviewed periodically and revised as necessary, in particular when:

- The introduction of new plant / processes.
- Organisational changes occur.
- Significant hazards are identified.
- New regulations are issued or existing regulations are revised, relevant to our business.
- Advances in health and safety knowledge become available.

This policy and any revision will be communicated to all personnel within the company by being displayed on notice boards.

The support of all staff in adhering to the health and safety policy will contribute towards managing risks associated with our business and will assist in the protection of all personnel and assets.
