Coronavirus (Covid-19) Statement

As the Coronavirus (COVID-19) continues to have an adverse effect on the global community, we are able to confirm the steps TPG are taking to ensure business continuity for all our customers and suppliers.

TPG remains fully operational and alongside new and existing customer work we are also carrying out urgent plating of essential parts for use in ventilators currently being deployed in the NHS.

Whilst we continue to operate, the safety and wellbeing of our staff, customers and suppliers are of paramount importance. We have reviewed our operations based on World Health Organisation and government guidance and have made changes to specifically cater for the impact of COVID-19.

We have brought in measures to ensure hand cleansing is carried out by all staff on entering the factory and during the day. Physical distancing is also being maintained throughout the factory. In accordance with Government guidelines any member of staff with symptoms of Covid-19 will be isolated for 7 days and 14 days should a member of their household have symptoms.

The TPG customer and supplier support staff are available to take calls and emails as usual to support you with your requirements and any enquiries you may have.

Our operations team remain onsite to ensure our customers stay supported, and to accept supplier deliveries. Staff travel and face to face meetings with customers or suppliers, either at their site or ours, have been prohibited in line with social distancing. We continue to make customer deliveries, however, please let us know of any operational requirements you have put in place for your organisation which may impact on the way we interact with each other.

These are unprecedented times and TPG continues to follow the latest official advice with regard to COVID-19. We will ensure that our business operations will continue to operate as normal for as long as possible. However, if we are faced with government enforced closure, we will have no option but to declare force majeure on all contractual obligations.
